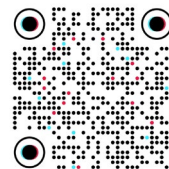

Onsite Activities



Welcome Talk

At your Welcome Talk, you will meet the President and/or VP, your Dean of Faculty and your Head of Department. You will meet our guest host Stephen Naughton who will also join you again at the end of the day over in the Students' Union.

At the end of this session, you will join your lecturers in smaller class groups for your Orientation and Guided Tour.

Campus Tour

You will be assigned to groups with your classmates ONSITE and a designated Lecturer will bring you around the campus and share essential course information and timetables. This is a great chance to get to know your way around, meet new people and learn about supports available to you.

Library

A library visit is part of the ONSITE activities, where you will learn about valuable library resources. Watch out for library competitions and promotions.

Getting Settled

During your ONSITE Induction, you will meet the staff of the Student Resource Centre who will be helping you throughout your time in TUS. In particular, we'll be talking with you about what to expect during this next exciting stage of your life and how to navigate the emotional side of things.

Active Consent

During your first week of class you are asked to attend an Active Consent session. We have 2 times available, with the option of either Wednesday or Thursday evening to facilitate your schedule, just pick one. These will be on your timetable which will be shared with you during Induction.

This initiative is part of a sector wide programme in support of ending sexual violence and harassment in 3rd Level.
