



How do I apply to repeat a failed module?

Students who have not successfully completed modules in Semester 1 or 2 must apply to repeat. This includes all types of modules i.e. final exam, practical's, continuous assessments, projects, work experience. The module will be assessed during Semester 3 / August Repeats.

If your repeat module is not a final exam, please contact your lecturer on the format and deadlines on submitting your work for assessment in Semester3.
