## What do I do if I have not successfully passed all modules by the end of the Academic Year?

## Q: I have not successfully passed a module/s in the Semester 3 (August Repeats) what are my options now?

A: If you have not successfully completed all of your modules by the end of your Academic Year, there are several options available to you:

1. Repeat & Attend

Remain in the same year of study and repeat only failed modules

- 2. Sit exams as an external candidate (Resit) Register as an external student and complete the outstanding element as advised by your lecturer, you will not be able to attend classes
- 3. Progress & Carry

Only students who are eligible to progress & carry will be invited to do so within 2 weeks of the release of Semester 3 results. Students will progress into their next year, but must attempt the carried module(s) during the new Academic Year.
