


What should I do if I haven't passed all my modules by the end of the Academic year?



What should I do if I haven't passed all my modules by the end of the Academic year?

Question: I haven't passed some modules in Semester 3 (August Repeats). What can I do now?

Answer: If you haven't successfully completed all your modules by the end of the Academic Year, you have a few options: -

1. Repeat & Attend

Stay in your current year of study and retake only the modules you did not pass.

Students who wish to Repeat & Attend in the Academic Year 2025 / 2026 must discuss their application with their Faculty before completing the form which is available online.

2. Resit Exams as an External Candidate

Register as an external student and complete the outstanding elements as directed by your lecturer. Note that you won't be able to attend regular classes.

External Repeat Module Application closing dates provided below: -

Exam Sessions	Date
Semester One	10 th October 2025
Semester Two	6 th March 2026
Repeat Exams/August	17 th July 2026

3. Progress & Carry

Only students who meet the criteria for Progress & Carry will be invited to do so within two weeks of the Semester 3 results release. Eligible students will advance to the next year of study but must attempt the carried module(s) during the new Academic Year.

<u>Note</u>: - To be considered for **Progress & Carry** into the next Academic Year, you should have attempted your exams in both available sessions (Semester 1 or 2 **AND** the August Repeat session).
