

demands of the job market and fosters a sense of relevance and applicability in their chosen field.



Blockchain gives students ownership of their personal records, allowing them to control their academic identity.



Blockchair

Blockchain is a **system of recording information** in a way that makes it difficult or impossible to change the system. It is a **digital ledger** of transactions that is duplicated and **distributed** across the entire network of computer systems on the blockchain.


Blockchain is a registry or journal (*ledger*), which does not have a central authority to control the database (*decentralized*), which involves many participants who store information (*distributed*) and operates safely due to securing information from unauthorized access (*cryptographic* rules).

Blockchain is a registry that is distributed among many participants with no central entity to control. The goal of blockchain is to allow digital information to be recorded and distributed but not edited. In this way, a blockchain is a foundation for immutable ledgers or records of transactions that cannot be altered, deleted or destroyed.

Blockchain is named as an immutable ledger, because once it is created, it cannot be changed or tampered with because of the special technique of securing information, which is called cryptography.






Digital Credentials Successful Project by University of Lille, France
