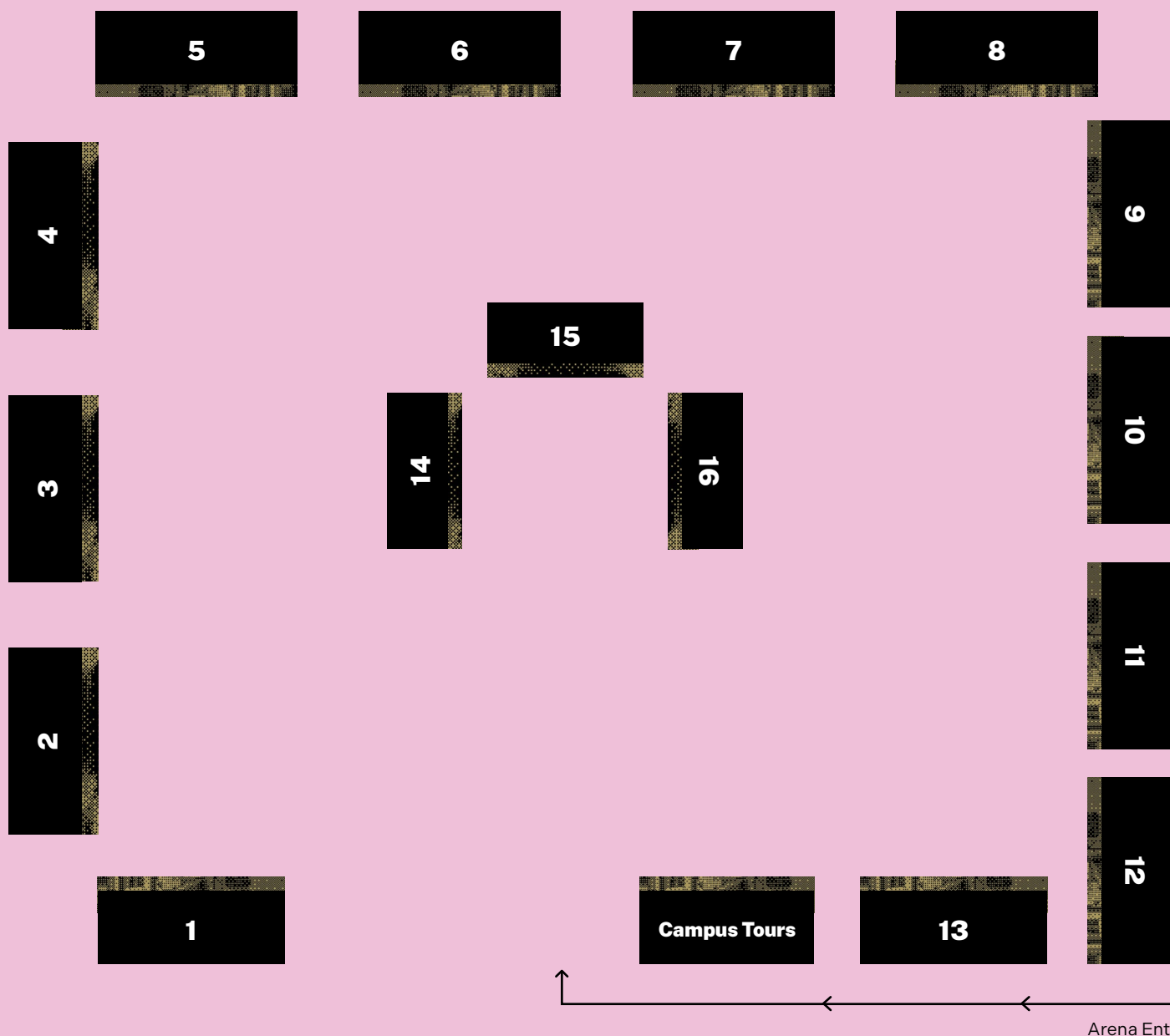

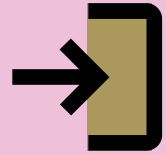

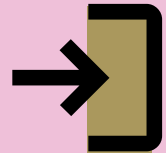
Accommodation

Admissions

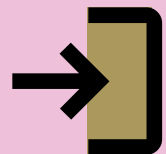
Our admissions team will be available to talk you through everything from entry requirements, your CAO application, accepting your offer and any other questions you may have on the application process.



Sport, Scholarships and Societies

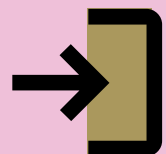

Student Supports

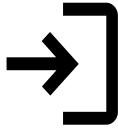
