


Engineering Week 2023



We engage in a student mentoring programme with BITCI and Thomond Community College which strives to encourage students to stay in school, increase their self-esteem and develop an awareness of the workplace over the course of their senior cycle. This programme involves a two-year commitment from TUS employees who agree to be a mentor to one student during their senior cycle in school.
