

Access to Apprenticeship

This is a 12 week full time Access programme that runs 3 times a year (September, January and April), preparing young people aged 16 to 24 years for an Apprenticeship.

The programme is validated as a Level 6 Continuous Professional Development Certificate - 30 ECTs.

It targets young people from under represented communities to progress into a craft apprenticeship.

Core modules

- **Skills Sampling:** Try a range of trades including Electrical, Mechanics, Fitting, Welding, Carpentry & Joinery and Plumbing.
- Personal and Professional Development: Enhance your skills and confidence to progress into employment.
- Work placement: Two weeks work placement based on your chosen career.

Entry Requirements

3 out of 5 required:

- Do you live in an area of disadvantage?
- Did your parent(s) or guardian not go to college?
- · Did you attend a DEIS School?
- Are you in receipt of medical/GP visit card?
- Is your household income below €45,790 / Are you or yours parents on a means tested payment?

AND/OR have you been in the care of the state?
