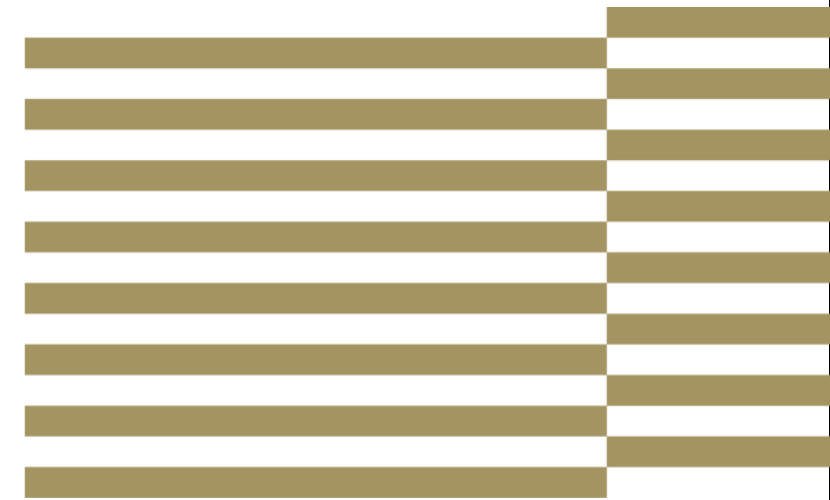

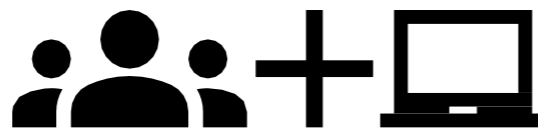
DELIVERY METHODS

Programmes delivered through traditional face-to-face lectures and tutorials.



Online

Blended

Springboard+, ICT Skills & Human Capital Initiative



What is Springboard+?

Springboard+ provides free and heavily funded places on programmes aimed at upskilling and reskilling in specifically identified areas of skills need or shortage. Springboard+ will enable you to move your career to the next level, learn new skills, enhance your existing skills, and get the promotion or job you have always dreamed of. Springboard+ provides free college courses for people who are unemployed, returning to the workforce or were previously self-employed. If you are already working, you can also participate in Springboard+ course by paying a fee of 10% of the overall course fee. It is the ultimate method of upskilling/ reskilling.

ICT Skills Conversion Programmes

ICT programmes are targeted at applicants who already hold a Level 8 or equivalent qualification and are seeking an honours degree qualification in ICT programming skills. These types of courses are developed in collaboration with tech industries and sectors and are at pace with the ever-evolving landscape that is ICT. Some courses involve a 3-month work placement, in person attendance and others are 100% online.

Human Capital Initiative (HCI) Pillar 1

HCI programmes are full-time graduate conversion courses in areas of identified skills need. The objective of HCI is to future-proof graduates with industry relevant skills for emerging technologies. HCI programmes are open to all categories - Recent Graduates (90% funded), employed (90% funded), unemployed (100% funded), formerly self-employed and returners to employment (100% funded). Applicants MUST hold a Level 8 qualification or be assessed under Recognised Prior Learning (RPL).



Who is Eligible for Springboard+?

- The unemployed or formerly self-employed**
All courses are open to these applicants, except for the two-year part-time ICT conversion courses, which are not open to those in receipt of a Jobseeker related payment.
- Returners (Formerly known as Homemakers)**
All courses are open to these applicants provided they meet the eligibility requirements for the funding - nationality/ VISA/ residency/ proof of status (affidavit or notarised returner form)
- People in employment**
All courses are open to these applicants provided they meet the eligibility requirements for the funding - nationality/ VISA/ residency/ proof of employment.
- Recent Graduates**
One year full-time and 2-year part-time ICT skills conversion courses are open to recent graduates. However, to apply for a Level 9 post-graduate course, applicants must allow one year to pass after completing the undergraduate degree course at Level 8.

Applicants from categories #1 and #2 will be able to avail of places on Level 7, 8 & 9 courses free of charge.

Places on Level 6 courses are FREE to all applicants, providing they fulfil the eligibility requirements for the funding - nationality, VISA, residency.

Applicants from categories #3 and #4 will be liable for the fee of 10% of the overall course fee (e.g. Course fee is €7,000 - applicant from categories 3 & 4 must pay €700) provided they fulfil the eligibility requirements.

This 10% must be paid before the course commences and is non - refundable.

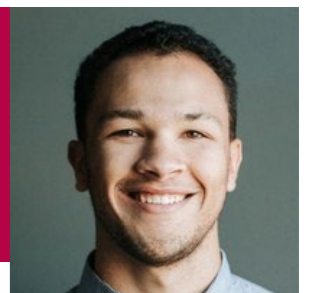

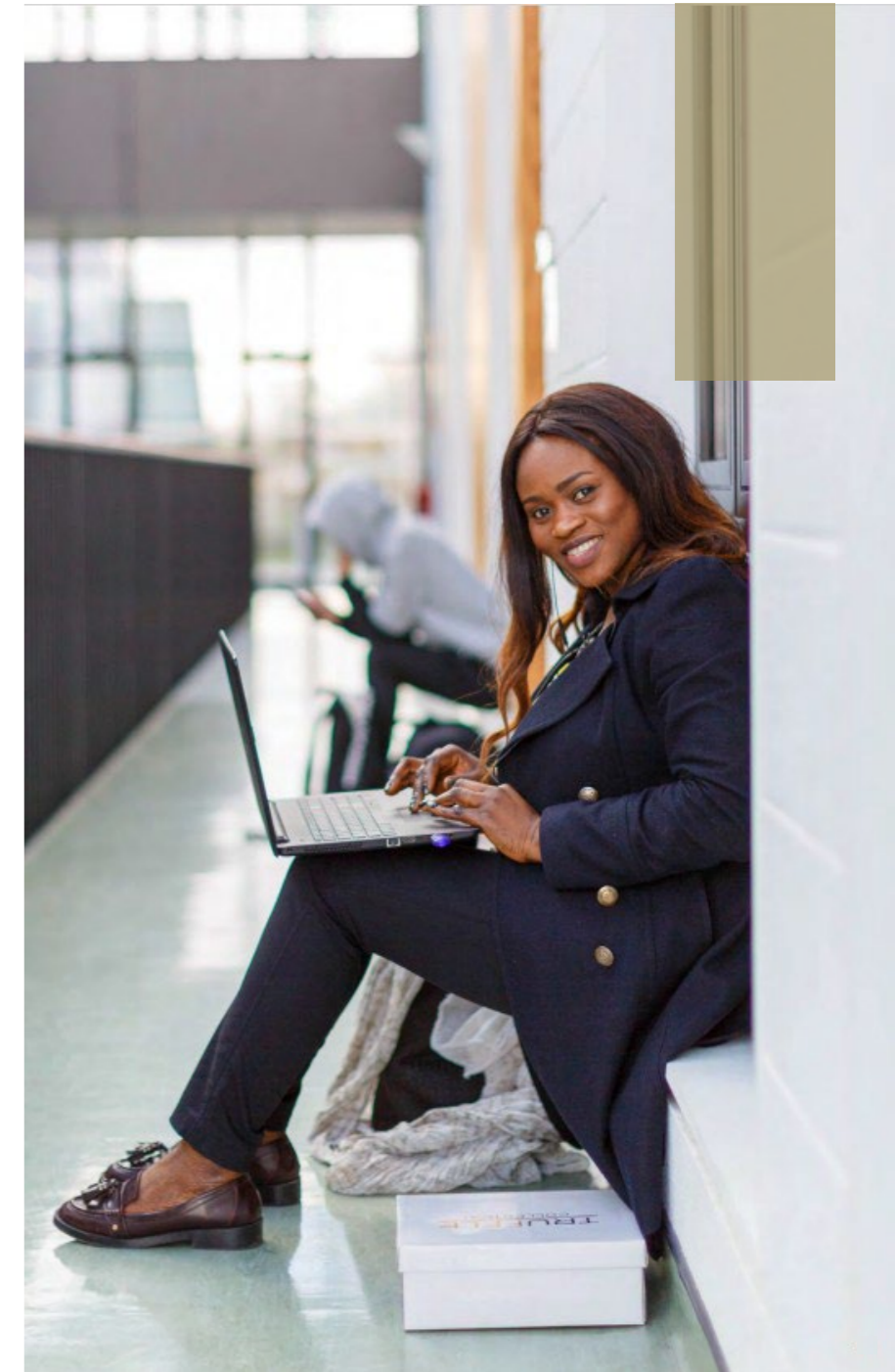
Recognition of Prior Learning

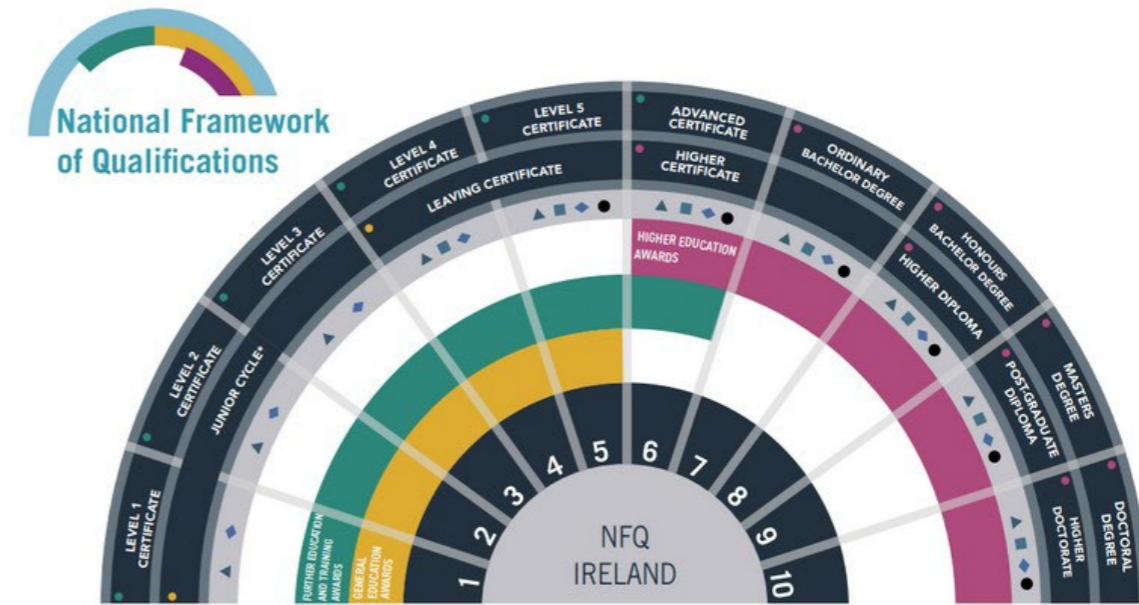

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What are Learning Credits? ECTS

The European Credit Transfer and Accumulation System (ECTS) is an academic credit system based on the estimated student workload required to achieve the objectives and learning outcomes of a module or programme of study. It is designed to enable academic recognition for periods of study, to facilitate student mobility and credit accumulation and transfer. The ECTS is the recommended credit system for higher education in Ireland and across the European Higher Education Area.

For example: 60 ECTS credits are allocated to the learning outcomes and associated workload of a full-time academic year or its equivalent. A full-time honours degree is usually 240 ECTS spread over 4 years.

Technological University of the Shannon offers short programmes of 10 ECTS up to full awards of 120, 180 and 240 ECTS.

ECTS express the volume of learning based on defined learning outcomes and their associated workload and are expressed in full numbers. 1 ECTS equates to approximately 20 to 25 hours student work.

Student Profile

Why did you choose to study at TUS?

My journey started back in 2019, when I got the chance to enrol on a Springboard+ course, developed by TUS. This marked the beginning of a new chapter in my academic career, as well as of my life. I was coming from a business background and deciding to change my career path to a new area, software engineering, was a big step – though it was one I was extremely excited to explore. This was also my very first experience of studying abroad and having the chance to do it in a highly recognised institution, such as TUS.

What mode of study did you choose and why?

I started a HDip in Science in Software Development (Cloud Application Development) as part of the Springboard+ programme, upon completion of which I enrolled in the Master of Science in Applied Software Engineering (Ericsson). I did opt for the full-time mode of study when doing my diploma. I knew that getting into a new area would require greater effort and more time allocated, so I decided to fully focus on the programme and dedicate as much time as possible to the course.

What are the most difficult and most enjoyable aspects of your programme?

I moved from my home country, Moldova, to Ireland the year before I started my HDip programme, so starting this course was just a great chance for me to meet new people here in Ireland and to make friends. This helped me to acclimatise myself quicker, which was great. Perseverance is key, and the fantastic support I have received from TUS lecturers has helped me overcome any difficulties and stay motivated. I really value the personal interaction I have had with them along the process. TUS provides an amazing array of resources which are intended to facilitate the student experience, and I was very happy to make use of them.

What advice would you give to prospective researchers/postgraduate students?

If you've got a genuine commitment to continuous learning and improvement, you'll do great. Don't fear new challenges just because you think they might result in failures; instead, challenge your beliefs about what you can do. Venture outside of your comfort zone. The fear of failing can cause us to do nothing and, therefore, resist moving forward. And because of this, we're likely to miss some great opportunities along the way.

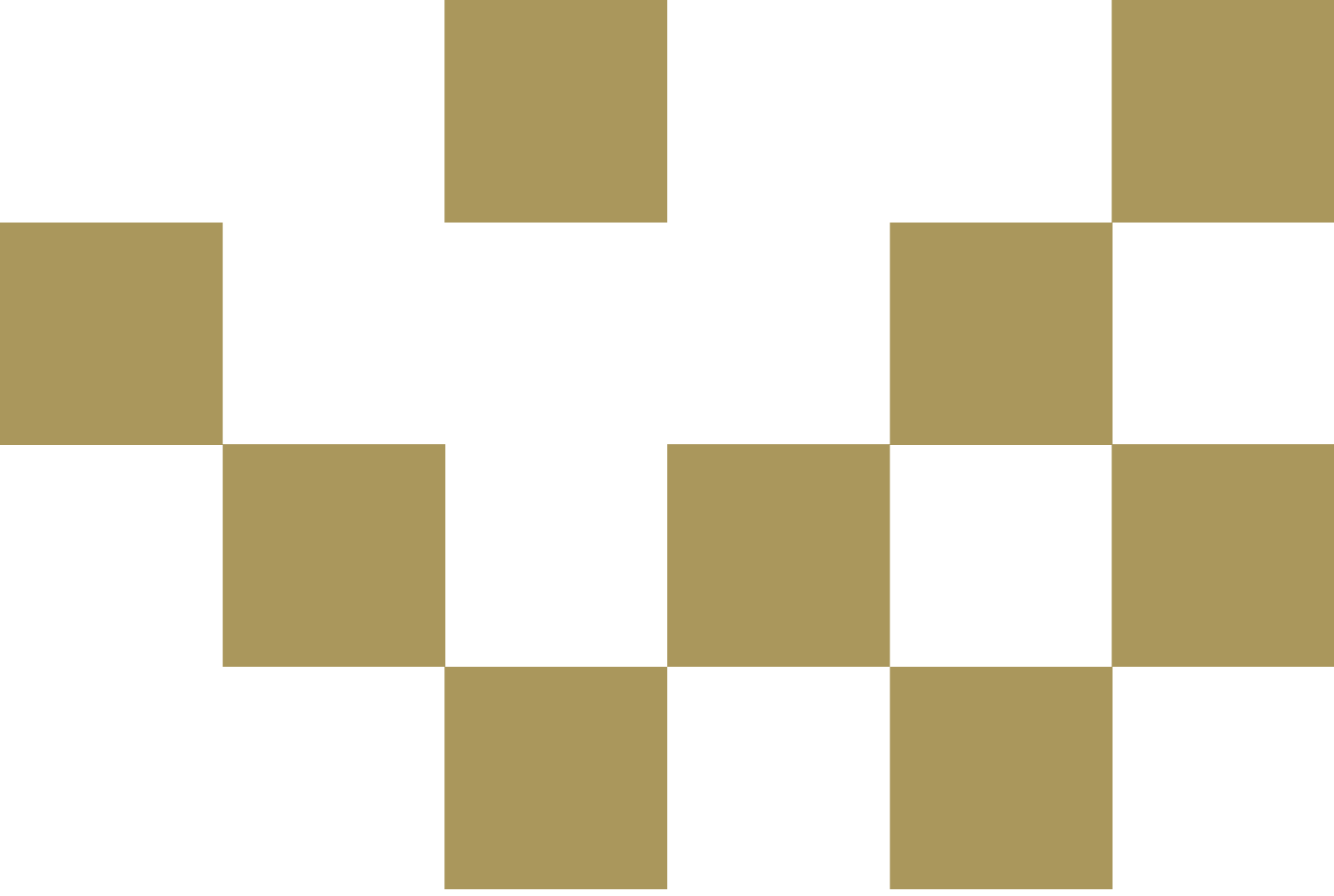
