

Terms & Conditions (T&Cs) for the birthday party service:

1. Party Duration & Format

- Each birthday party booking includes 2 hours of supervised activities and use of the party room for food.
 - All parties are led by trained coaches who will run a variety of age-appropriate physical activities.
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2. Activities

- A wide range of activities is available, including:
Long Jump, High Jump, Shot Putt, Relay Races, Soccer, GAA, Dodgeball, and Obstacle Courses.
 - Activities may vary depending on the location and are subject to coach availability.
 - Activity selection will be tailored to suit the interests and age of the birthday child where possible.
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3. Age Suitability

- Parties are suitable for children aged 5 to 13 years only.
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4. Venues

- Parties are hosted at one of the following locations (subject to availability):
 - **The Arena**
 - **Count John McCormack Hall**
 - Activity options may differ based on the chosen venue.
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5. Party Room & Catering

- A party room is provided for food after the activities.
 - Hosts may bring their own food or arrange for food delivery.
 - Diluted drinks, paper plates, napkins, and basic partyware are included.
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6. Party Invitations

- Free party invitations are available. These can be:
 - Collected in person from the venue, or
 - Downloaded online via the provided link.
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7. Pricing & Payment

- The standard cost is **€140 for up to 14 children**.
 - An additional charge of **€10 per child** applies for each child beyond the initial 14.
 - A **non-refundable deposit of €50** is required to secure a booking.
 - Full payment must be made **prior to or on the day** of the party.
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8. Booking & Availability

- All bookings are subject to availability.
 - Due to high demand, early booking is strongly recommended.

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9. Cancellations & Refunds

- The **€50 deposit is non-refundable** under all circumstances.
 - In the event of cancellation, the remaining balance (if paid) may be refunded at the discretion of management.

- Coaches will lead and supervise activities; however, at least one parent or guardian must remain on-site for the duration of the party.
 - Children are expected to behave in a respectful and safe manner.
 - We reserve the right to end a party early in the event of unsafe or disruptive behaviour.
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
